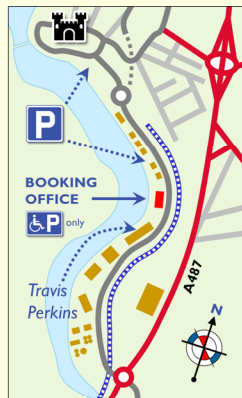

CAERNARFON STATION:

While we work on a new station building, our Booking Office and Gift Shop have been moved to alternative premises - located just a short distance further along St Helen's Road, next to Travis Perkins Builders Merchants.

Trains will still use the original station, but with pedestrian access available from the far end of the platform, close to the new Booking Office.

Parking - a limited number of Disabled spaces are available beside our new premises. There is a small car park next to Gwynedd Tyres, while the large Slate Quay car park is just a few minutes walk away, close to the castle.



Times shown in **RED** indicate where trains pass each other at stations. Passengers can transfer from one train to another by crossing the platform providing the option of a shorter or longer journey, as applicable.
